If you're receiving this email, it's because we know you have a heart for refugees, their stories, and the new life they are starting here in America.

We wanted to make their stories even more real to you.

What: Screening and discussion of life in modern day North Korea- through National Geographic's "Inside North Korea" with Lisa Ling.

When: Tuesday, July 13 at 7pm

Why: Because knowing, at least in small part, what refugees have gone through enables us to understand how to meet them where they are.

Our organization (LiNK|Liberty in North Korea) is currently working on a modern day underground-railroad, helping refugees who have escaped North Korea to find freedom. By North Korean law it is illegal to leave the country. However, many North Koreans face starvation if they stay (in addition to complete religious oppression and persecution), so they risk their lives to flee to China where they must live in hiding. If caught, they will be sent back to North Korea and executed or put into a concentration camp. We are trying to help them <http://www.linkglobal.org/>
