Traditionally the festival takes place at the time of the August full moon, when the Karen people tie white and red threads around their wrists to ward off illness and to contribute to the continuation of Karen culture. It was started to remind them that although they are scattered, they are all related. The Karen people are one of the nine Burmese tribes.
