Before that, he was a principal at Morgan Stanley, responsible for building its China office and also a senior banker at the China Construction Bank (CCB). Mr. Xu sits on the board of GuangCai 49 Group, a chamber of commerce for leading Chinese entrepreneurs and is an independent board director of Synthesis Energy Systems (SYM) amongst his many board members. He also advises Clayton Dubilier & Rice on China matters.

He is also a co-founder and chairman of the board of trustees of Xi Wai International School, a bilingual K-12 school in Shanghai.
